The appearance of the human upper eyelid often varies between different populations. The prevalence of an epicanthic fold covering the inner corner of the eye account for the majority of East Asian and Southeast Asian populations, and is also found in varying degrees among other populations. Separately, but also similarly varying between populations, the crease of the remainder of the eyelid may form either a "single eyelid", a "double eyelid", or an intermediate form.

Its key function is to regularly spread the tears and other secretions on the eye surface to keep it moist, since the cornea must be continuously moist. They keep the eyes from drying out when asleep. This can be either voluntarily or involuntarily. A set of specialized hairs known as lashes grow from the upper and lower eyelid margins to further protect the eye from dust and debris. "Palpebral" (and "blepharal") means relating to the eyelids. Moreover, the blink reflex protects the eye from foreign bodies

In at least 90% of new cases, progression to more aggressive forms of sight-threatening retinopathy and maculopathy could be reduced with proper treatment and monitoring of the eyes. The longer a person has diabetes, the higher their chances of developing diabetic retinopathy. Each year in the United States, diabetic retinopathy accounts for 12% of all new cases of blindness. Astigmatism refractive error due to rotational asymmetry in the eye's refractive power. The lens and cornea of an eye without astigmatism are nearly spherical, with only Astigmatism is a type of refractive error due to rotational asymmetry in the eye's refractive power. If it occurs in early life and is left untreated, it may result in amblyopia. Often it is present at birth, but it can change or develop later in life, and so can affect people of all ages. Astigmatism can lead to symptoms that include eyestrain, headaches, and trouble driving at night. In an eye with astigmatism, either the lens or the cornea is slightly egg-shaped, with higher curvature in one direction than the other. This gives distorted or blurred vision at any distance and requires corrective lenses that apply different optical powers at different rotational angles. The lens and cornea of an eye without astigmatism are nearly spherical, with only a single radius of curvature, and any refractive errors present can be corrected with simple glasses

If this is not effective, injecting corticosteroids into the lesion may be tried. If the granuloma is large, incision and drainage may be recommended. Delicate contours were incised into the paint before firing, and details could be reinforced and highlighted with opaque colors, usually white and red. The principal centers for this style were initially the commercial hub Corinth, and later Athens. Other important production sites are known to have been in Laconia, Boeotia, eastern Greece, and Italy. Particularly in Italy individual styles developed which were at least in part intended for the Etruscan market.
