A few minutes into the journey, a small, bright asteroid passes within a few hundred yards of them, but does not collide with the projectile. The asteroid had been captured by the Earth's gravity and had become a second moon. ba351d7adf

Georges Méliès His most important films include *A Trip to the Moon* (1902) and *The Impossible Voyage* (1904). *A Trip to the Moon*. prominence to Méliès films such as. Méliès rose to prominence creating "trick films" and became well known for his innovative use of special effects, popularizing such techniques as substitution splices, multiple exposures, time-lapse photography, dissolves, and hand-painted colour. He led many technical and narrative developments in the early days of cinema, primarily in the fantasy and science fiction genres. Consequently, Méliès received but a small fraction of the considerable profits earned by the film *Marie-Georges-Jean Méliès* (mayl-YES, French: [mari ʒɔʁʒ ʒɑ̃ meljɛs]; 8 December 1861 – 21 January 1938) was a French filmmaker, actor, magician, and toymaker. He was also one of the first filmmakers to use storyboards in his work ba351d7adf

The novel (along with Wells's The First Men in the Moon) inspired the first science fiction film, A Trip to the Moon, made in 1902 by Georges Méliès; From the Earth to the Moon: A Direct Route in 97 Hours, 20 Minutes (French: De la Terre à la Lune, trajet direct en 97 heures 20 minutes) is an 1865 novel by Jules Verne.
