Feral cat Feral cats may breed over dozens of generations and become a mesopredator or even a local apex predator in urban, savannah and bushland environments, especially on islands where native animals did not evolve alongside natural predators. Some feral cats may become more comfortable with people who regularly feed them, but even with long-term attempts at socialization, they usually remain aloof and are most active after dusk. Trap-neuter-return Feral cats cannot be socialized, shun most human interaction and do not fare well in confinement, so they are not retained. Implementation of TNR is often also accompanied with the introduction of new laws that prevent land owners from removing feral cats from their properties, as well as protection from liability for people that feed and release feral cats. Cats suffering from severe medical problems such as terminal, contagious, or untreatable illnesses or injuries are often euthanized. populations of feral cats. If the location is deemed unsafe or

The process involves live-trapping the cats, having them neutered, ear-tipped for identification, and, if possible, vaccinated, Trap–neuter–return (TNR), also known as trap–neuter–release, is a controversial method that attempts to manage populations of feral cats. Often, friendly adults and kittens young enough to be easily socialized are retained and placed for adoption. The process involves live-trapping the cats, having them neutered, ear-tipped for identification, and, if possible, vaccinated, then releasing them back into the outdoors b50dc714cf

Despite widespread scepticism, she opened the free "dispensary" in a basement on 17 November 1917. A sign outside read: "Bring your sick animals! Do not let them suffer! All animals treated. Dog breeds vary widely in shape, size, and color. Laws in the European Union and many U.S. states ban inhumane traps such as foothold traps, and instead promote body-grip traps, which kill animals quickly and are therefore regarded as more humane. All traps, whether for capture or killing, must be checked at least every 24 hours, and humane guidelines recommend more frequent checks and, where possible, the use of monitoring devices that alert when a trap is triggered. Because improper trapping can cause severe animal suffering and pose risks to pets, wildlife, and humans, specialized certification programs train professionals in humane and safe pest management. b50dc714cf == History == b50dc714cf After the Civil War, people's concerns were raised regarding animal abuse and cruelty. In the late 19th century organizations throughout the United States began to arise in the effort to protect animals. The Palmers recruited influential leaders to assist them in the creation of this organization such as Joseph Bryan, founder of the Richmond Times-Dispatch. The SPCA in Richmond struggled with its finances, but Nellie Palmer's aunt, Louisa Nalle, left her Richmond estate to Palmer upon her death. Not only did the Palmers have a new location for their shelter but, a sum of \$24,000 was left to the SPCA that could be used to advocate for animal protection. b50dc714cf

Vasectomy Caroline Deys, a noted Vasectomy is an elective surgical procedure that results in male sterilization, often as a means of permanent

contraception. During the procedure, the vasa deferentia are cut and tied or sealed so as to prevent sperm from entering into the urethra and thereby prevent fertilization of ova through sexual intercourse. Vasectomies are usually performed in a physician's office, medical clinic, or, when performed on a non-human animal, in a veterinary clinic. In Western countries free-ranging dogs are rare; in Europe they are primarily found in parts of Eastern Europe, and, to a lesser extent, in parts of Southern Europe. b50dc714cf Toxoplasmosis is usually spread by eating poorly cooked food that contains cysts, by exposure to infected cat feces, or from an infected woman to her baby during pregnancy. Rarely, the disease may be spread by blood transfusion or other organ transplant. It is thought to not otherwise spread between people, but broader transmissibility remains a matter of scientific debate. Studies have reported the presence of *T. gondii* in human semen and have proposed sexual transmission as a possible route, though this has not been established as a primary mode of spread. Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) advises that dogs not intended for further breeding should be neutered so that they do not have undesired puppies The dog (*Canis familiaris* or *Canis lupus familiaris*) is a domesticated descendant of wolves. Dogs were the first species to be domesticated over 14,000 years ago, before the development of agriculture, though genetic studies suggest the domestication process may have begun over 25,000 years ago.
