Noxious weed Noxious weeds are a major problem in many parts of the world, greatly affecting areas of agriculture, forest management, nature reserves, parks, and other open spaces. Most noxious weeds have been introduced into an ecosystem by ignorance, mismanagement, or accident. Typically, they are plants that grow aggressively, multiply quickly without natural controls (such as native herbivores or soil chemistry), and cause adverse effects upon contact or ingestion. Weed and Seward became leaders of the New York Anti-Masonic Party, and Weed established the Albany Evening Journal as the party's main newspaper. Weed supported the American System of Henry Clay and helped establish the Whig Party in the 1830s. Mechanical weed control Mechanical weed control is a physical activity that inhibits unwanted plant growth. A selective method has very little impact on non-target plants where as a non-selective method affects the entire area that is being treated. If mechanical control methods are applied at the optimal time and intensity, some weed species may be controlled or even eradicated. Mechanical control techniques can be either selective or non-selective. methods that remove, injure, kill, or make the growing conditions unfavorable. Other techniques may alter the growing environment by eliminating light, increasing the temperature of the soil, or depriving the plant of carbon dioxide or oxygen. Some of these methods cause direct damage to the weeds through complete removal or causing a lethal injury 9338737e4c

Federal Noxious Weed Act of 1974 2148, enacted January 3, 1975) established a federal program to control the spread of noxious weeds. 2148, enacted January 3, 1975) established a federal program to control the spread of The Federal Noxious Weed Act of 1974 ("FNWA", Pub. L. The United States Secretary of Agriculture was given the authority to declare plants "noxious weeds", and limit the interstate spread of such plants without a permit. After attaining admission to the bar, he settled in the village of Plattsburgh, where he practiced law and became involved in businesses including lumber, mines, and railroads. He served in the New York State Assembly in 1865, 1866, 1867, 1871, 1873 and 1874. In 1871, Weed's opposition to the Tammany Hall Democratic organization caused a pro-Tammany Assembly member to assault him; the member resigned rather than face expulsion. 9338737e4c

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
