Keratosis pilaris It most often appears on the outer sides of the upper arms (the forearms can also be affected), thighs, face, back, and buttocks; KP can also occur on the hands, and tops of legs, sides, or any body part except glabrous (hairless) skin (like the palms or soles of feet). Often the lesions can appear on the face, which may be mistaken for acne or folliculitis 1efaa26966

The cause of KP is not completely understood. As of 2018, KP is thought to be due to abnormalities in the deposition of the protein keratin in hair follicles, in the hair shaft, or in both. Follic hyperkeratosis and scarring alopecia are keratosis follicularis spinulosa decalvans clinical hallmarks. Early childhood or infancy is when follicular hyperkeratosis first appears on the face, affecting the nose, forehead, cheeks, and eyebrows. Alopecia areata that leaves scars on the scalp and eyebrows starts in early childhood and gets worse. Additional related features include excessive periungual cuticles, corneal dystrophy with photophobia, and palmoplantar keratoderma. 1efaa26966 The several types of KP have been associated with pregnancy, type 1 diabetes mellitus, obesity, dry skin, allergic diseases (e.g., atopic dermatitis), and rarely cancer. Many rarer types of the disorder are part of inherited genetic syndromes. 1efaa26966 Atrophoderma vermiculatum is characterized by the formation of keratotic, inflammatory papules on the face that atrophicate, leave behind pitted scars that resemble honeycombs or reticula. 1efaa26966 Keratosis pilaris atrophicans faciei manifests as follicular, horny papules encircled by an erythematous halo encompassing the chin, cheeks, forehead, and eyebrows.
