' The verb тошнить tošnit' has no standard personal An anticausative verb (abbreviated antic) is an intransitive verb that shows an event affecting its subject, while giving no semantic or syntactic indication of the cause of the event. One can assume that there is a cause or an agent of causation, but the syntactic structure of the anticausative makes it unnatural or impossible to refer to it directly. Examples of anticausative verbs are break, sink, move, etc. The single argument of the anticausative verb (its subject) is a patient, that is, what undergoes an action. Ivana tošnit. Similar pressure had been applied to singers such as Lena Horne, Barbra Streisand and Mel Tormé to record contemporary rock songs.
