Explanation 2615f26b64 == History == 2615f26b64 In 1992, the American Academy of Pediatrics recommended babies sleep on their backs to prevent sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS). Although the rate of SIDS has decreased by 50% since the Safe to Sleep campaign started in 1994, an unintended consequence was that babies missed out on the twelve or so hours they used to spend in the prone position while asleep, and there was a sharp increase in plagiocephaly (flat head syndrome) in infants. Breastfeeding This alignment helps to facilitate proper, efficient swallowing Breastfeeding, also known as nursing, is the process whereby breast milk is fed to an infant or toddler. The WHO recommends then continuing breastfeeding with appropriate complementary foods for up to 2 years, and beyond. Health organizations including the WHO recommend exclusively breastfeeding for six months; this means that no other foods or drinks—other than vitamin D supplement—are typically given. Infants may suckle directly from the breast, or milk may be extracted with a pump and then fed to the infant. Between 2015 and 2020, only about 44% of infants worldwide were exclusively breastfed in the first six months of life. The World Health

Organization (WHO) recommends that breastfeeding begin within the first hour of a newborn's birth and continue as the baby wants. which can be remembered as "tummy-to-mummy," and with their hips, shoulders, and head aligned

Gross motor skill These skills are built upon, improved and better controlled throughout early childhood, and continue in refinement throughout most of the individual's years of development into adulthood. "Tummy-time" is a good example of this. The children will typically learn head control, trunk stability, and then standing up and walking. muscles. It is shown that children exposed to outdoor play time activities will develop better gross motor skills. These gross movements come from large muscle groups and whole body movement. These skills develop in a head-to-toe order. By the time they reach two years of age, almost all children are able to stand up, walk and run, walk up stairs, etc. At first they are only able to lay their belly on the floor but by around two months they start to gain muscle Gross motor skills are the abilities usually acquired during childhood as part of a child's motor learning

== History == Motor skills are movements and actions of the muscles. Typically, they are categorized into two groups: gross motor skills and fine motor skills. Gross motor skills are involved in movement and coordination of the arms, legs, and other large body parts and movements. Infants put to sleep in the supine position have been found to reach motor developmental milestones (e.g. crawling, rolling, and sitting) at a slower rate compared to infants who sleep in the prone position. Holistic development sees the child in the round, as a whole person – physically, emotionally, intellectually, socially, morally, culturally, and spiritually.
