

# Picture Of Animal Cell

When the information from the sender changes the behavior of a receiver, the information is referred to as a "signal". Active in over 40 countries, the ALF operates through clandestine cells, often consisting of small groups or individuals. This decentralized and covert structure makes it challenging for authorities to monitor or infiltrate the organization.
