== Overview == 449149cb03 PBD has been proposed as an explanation for periods of extreme mood swings, called mood episodes. These episodes alternate between depression or irritability and highly elevated moods, called manic or hypomanic episodes. Mixed mood episodes can occur when someone with PBD experiences depressive and manic symptoms simultaneously. PBD mood episodes differ from general mood swings experienced by children and adolescents, as mood episodes may persist over an extended period of several weeks or years, and may cause severe disruptions to an individual's life. 449149cb03 This new insight on ADHD is further reflected in the DSM-5, which lists ADHD as a disorder and has distinct requirements for children and adults. Per DSM-5 criteria, children must display "six or more symptoms in either the inattentive or hyperactive-impulsive domain, or both," for the diagnosis... 449149cb03

PBD and ADHD, in particular, have many overlapping symptoms, such as the hyperactivity characteristic of manic episodes. (DMDD) 449149cb03

Each question measures the frequency of the behavior, in which the respondent is asked to indicate whether the behavior occurs "always or very often", "often", "somewhat", or "rarely or never". The questionnaire is intended to be filled out by parents and teachers of the child or adolescent. The first nine items ask questions about behavior related to inattention (e.g., "has difficulty organizing task and activities"). The second set of nine items ask questions about behavior related to symptoms of

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hyperactivity and impulsivity (e.g., "talks excessively"). The last question asks if the behaviors were present before... 449149cb03

Achenbach. 449149cb03 Impairments resulting from deficits in self-regulation such as time management, cognitive inhibition, task initiation, and sustained attention can include poor professional performance, relationship difficulties, and numerous health risks, collectively predisposing to a diminished quality of life and a reduction in life expectancy. According to the DSM-5 diagnostic criteria, multiple symptoms should have been present before the age of 12. Approximately two-thirds of children with ADHD continue to experience impairing symptoms into adulthood, with symptoms ranging from minor inconveniences to impairments in daily functioning, and up to one-third continue to meet the full diagnostic criteria. It is a neurodevelopmental disorder, meaning impairing symptoms must have been present in childhood, except for when ADHD occurs after traumatic brain injury. ADHD was previously thought to be a childhood disorder that improved with age, but later research challenged this theory. This was implemented to add flexibility in the diagnosis of adults 449149cb03
