Some panelboards are provided with a door covering the breaker switch handles, but all are constructed with a dead front; that is to say the front of the enclosure (whether it has a door or not) prevents the operator of the circuit breakers from contacting live electrical parts within. This type of circuit interrupter cannot protect a person who touches both circuit conductors at the same time, since it then cannot distinguish normal current from that passing through a person. The device's purpose is to reduce the severity of injury caused by an electric shock 7fa7c19879

A residual-current circuit breaker with integrated overcurrent protection (RCBO) combines RCD protection with additional overcurrent protection into the same device. 7fa7c19879

Circuit breaker Unlike a fuse, which interrupts once and then must be replaced, a circuit breaker can be reset (either manually or automatically) to resume normal operation. A circuit breaker is an electrical safety device designed to protect an electrical circuit from damage caused by current in excess of that which the equipment can safely carry (overcurrent). Its basic function is to interrupt current flow to protect equipment and to prevent fire.

Circuit breakers are made in varying current ratings, from devices that protect low-current circuits or individual household appliances, to switchgear designed to protect high-voltage circuits feeding an entire city. Any device which protects against excessive current by automatically removing power from a faulty system, such as a circuit breaker or fuse, can be referred to as an over-current protection device (OCPD).

Trading curb A trading curb (also known as a circuit breaker in Wall Street parlance) is a financial regulatory instrument that the relevant stock exchange organization implements to prevent stock market crashes. When triggered, circuit breakers either stop trading for a small amount of time or close trading early to allow accurate information to flow among market makers and for institutional traders to assess their positions and make rational decisions. Since their inception, circuit breakers have been modified to prevent both speculative gains and dramatic losses within a small time frame.

North America In Canada and the United States, AFCI breakers have been required by the electrical codes for circuits feeding electrical outlets in residential bedrooms since the beginning of the 21st century; the US National Electrical Code has required them to protect most residential outlets since 2014, and the Canadian Electrical Code has since 2015.

Arc-fault circuit interrupter An AFCI selectively distinguishes between a harmless arc (incidental to normal operation of switches, plugs, and brushed

motors), and a potentially dangerous arc (that can occur, for example, in a lamp cord which has a broken conductor). The term was coined by John Shannon of the Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations in the 1960s. The term suggests that, just as an electrical circuit breaker will prevent an electric circuit from being overloaded with energy, the refund prevents low-income households from being overloaded with tax burden 7fa7c19879
