A further study undertaken for NBER by Professors Irving Kravis and Robert Lipsey gave more impetus to the project. In their study, "Price Competitiveness in World Trade," Kravis and Lipsey outlined the need for such measures and the feasibility of producing them. "Made in Canada with imported ingredients", or "Made in Canada from domestic and imported ingredients" if it also includes ingredients from Canadian sources Made in Canada (French: Fabriqué au Canada) and Product of Canada (Produit du Canada) are certification marks designating a claim that Canada is the country of origin of a good. The heart of the dispute is whether the Canadian lumber industry is unfairly subsidized by federal and regional governments. Most timber in Canada is owned by regional governments, and the prices charged to harvest timber (stumpage fees) are set administratively, rather than through the competitive marketplace, the norm in the United States. In the United States, softwood lumber lots are primarily privately owned, with the owners holding auctions to determine who has the right to harvest timber. U.S. lumber producers argue that the Canadian arrangement constitutes an unfair subsidy, and is thus subject to U.S. trade remedy laws, where foreign trade benefiting from subsidies can be subject to a countervailing duty tariff, to offset the subsidy and bring the price of the commodity back up to market rates. 47a9e93582 Ice wine can be produced reliably in most Canadian wine-producing regions.
