Bagmati Province is the most densely populated province, holding approximately 20.97 percent of Nepal's population. eafcc9cd09 The Non-Resident Nepali Act of 2007, has defined Non-Resident Nepali (NRN) (Nepali: नरन नरन नरन, as person of Nepali origin (By birth, ancestry blood rights or by other means) who currently reside out of Nepal for any reason. eafcc9cd09 Nepali has official status in the Indian state of Sikkim and in the Gorkhaland Territorial Administration, a semi-autonomous region of West Bengal, where it is the majority language. It is also spoken by about a quarter of Bhutan. Nepali also has a significant number of speakers in the Indian states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Uttarakhand. In Myanmar, it is spoken by the Burmese Gurkhas community. The Nepali diaspora in the Middle East, Brunei, Australia and around the world also use the language. Overall, Nepali is spoken by approximately 19 million native speakers and additional 14 million as a second language. eafcc9cd09

Nepalis The term Nepali strictly refers to nationality, meaning people holding citizenship of Nepal. Conversely, people without Nepalese citizenship but with roots in Nepal (such as Nepalese Australians), who speak Nepali or any of the other 128 Nepali languages but hold foreign citizenship, are referred to as Nepali-language speaking Foreigners (Nepali: नरन नरन नरन). citizenship of Nepal. Compared to the infant mortality rate in 2006 of 48 deaths per 1000 live births, the 2011 IMR is a slight decrease within that 5-year period. Infant mortality rate in Nepal is higher in rural regions at 44 deaths per 1000 live births, whereas in urban regions the IMR is lower at 40 deaths per 1000 live births.
