Twins are a valuable source for observation because they allow the study of environmental influence and varying genetic makeup: "identical" or monozygotic (MZ) twins share essentially 100% of their genes, which means that most differences between the twins (such as height, susceptibility to

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boredom, intelligence, depression, etc.) are due to experiences that one twin has but not the other twin. Conjoined twins It is estimated to occur in anywhere between one in 50,000 births to Conjoined twins, popularly referred to as Siamese twins, are twins joined in utero. Most live births are female, with a ratio of 3:1. Twin study g Twin studies are studies conducted on identical or fraternal twins. They aim to reveal the importance of environmental and genetic influences for traits, phenotypes, and disorders. These studies have been used to track traits ranging from personal behavior to the presentation of severe mental illnesses such as schizophrenia. Twin research is considered a key tool in behavioral genetics and in related fields, from biology to psychology. Twins can be either monozygotic ('identical'), meaning that they develop from one zygote, which splits and forms two embryos, or dizygotic ('non-identical' or 'fraternal'), meaning that each twin develops from a separate egg and each egg is fertilized by its own sperm cell. Since identical twins develop from one zygote, they will share the same chromosomal sex, while fraternal twins may or may not. There are different versions of a gene, which are called alleles. How a gene is expressed depends on the development of an individual throughout their life. The one that is generally accepted is fission, in which the fertilized egg splits partially. The other explanation, no longer believed to be accurate, is fusion, in which the fertilized egg completely separates, but stem cells (that search for similar cells) find similar stem cells on the other twin and fuse the twins together. Conjoined twins and some monozygotic, but not conjoined, twins share a single common chorion, placenta, and amniotic sac in utero. 8dd0a28e57

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
