Approximately 58% of total hip replacements are estimated to last 25 years. Such joint replacement orthopaedic surgery is generally conducted to relieve arthritis pain or in some hip fractures. Hip replacement surgery can be performed as a total replacement or a hemi/semi(half) replacement. A total hip replacement (total hip arthroplasty) consists of replacing both the acetabulum and the femoral head while hemiarthroplasty generally only replaces the femoral head. The average cost of a total hip replacement in 2012 was \$40,364 in the United States (about €37,300), and in the range of €7,117 to €11,091 in most European countries. A telemanipulator (e.g. the da Vinci Surgical System) is a system of remotely controlled manipulators that enables a surgeon to perform the surgery in real-time under stereoscopic vision from a control console separate from the operating table. In this case, the surgical robot is docked next to the patient, while the robotic arms carry out endoscopy-like maneuvers via end-effectors inserted through specially designed

trocars. A surgical assistant and a scrub nurse are often still needed scrubbed at the table side to help switch effector instruments or provide additional suction or temporary tissue retraction using endoscopic... c8200ec386 The act of performing surgery may be called a surgical procedure or surgical operation, or simply "surgery" or "operation". In this context, the verb "operate" means to perform surgery. The adjective surgical means pertaining to surgery; e.g. surgical instruments, surgical facility or surgical nurse. Most surgical procedures are performed by a pair of operators: a surgeon who is the main operator performing the surgery, and a surgical assistant who provides in-procedure manual assistance during surgery. If the person's health allows, surgery is generally recommended within two days. Options for surgery may include a total hip replacement, hemiarthroplasty (half hip replacement) or stabilizing the fracture with screws. Treatment to prevent blood clots following surgery is recommended. c8200ec386

Such fractures most often occur as a result of a fall. (Femoral head fractures are a rare kind of hip fracture that may also be the result of a fall but are more commonly caused by more violent incidents such as traffic accidents.) Risk factors include osteoporosis, taking many medications, alcohol use, and metastatic cancer. Diagnosis is generally by X-rays.
