The mainspring replaced the weight hanging from a cord wrapped around a pulley, which was the power source used in all previous mechanical clocks. ce1689ea57 8 mm cameras and projectors were originally designed for 16 frames per second, but this was later changed by some manufacturers to higher speeds to reduce flickering. Most cameras designed for 8 mm film were made with consumers in mind. Typical features include spring-wound operation, lightweight camera bodies, small viewfinders, and single, fixed lenses. Only brief scenes could be filmed without pausing to rewind the spring or flip the film spool. The plant is caespitose and decumbent, with a woody taproot. The green and terete stems have a whitish pubescence below the inflorescences. The leaves are sessile or have short petioles measuring 0.5 mm (0.020 in) long. The ovate, oblong, or elliptic leaves are 2-15 mm (0.079-0.591 in) long and 2-10 mm (0.079-0.394 in) wide. The chartaceous leaves have pale pubescent to pruinose undersides and are puberulous or glabrous above. The leaves are typically flat or have recurved margins. The leaf apices are rounded, the margins are entire, and the bases are rounded. == Modern mainsprings == ce1689ea57 *Pterostylis vernalis* is a terrestrial, perennial, deciduous, herb with an underground tuber and when not flowering, a rosette of three to seven egg-shaped, dark green leaves 5-15 mm (0.2-0.6 in) long and 4-10 mm (0.2-0.4 in) wide. Flowering plants have up to four flowers but not all are open at the same time. The flowers are 8-10 mm (0.3-0.4 in) long, about 4 mm (0.2 in) wide, green with a white patch near the base and dark brown near the tip. They are borne on a thin, wiry flowering stem 100-200 mm (4-8 in) high, each flower on a separate pedicel 1-9 mm (0.04-0.4 in) long. The dorsal sepal and petals are fused, forming a hood or "galea" over the column. The dorsal sepal is erect near its base, then curves forward... ce1689ea57 Washers are usually metal or plastic. High-quality bolted joints require hardened steel washers to prevent the loss of pre-load due to brinelling after the torque is applied. Washers are also important for preventing galvanic corrosion, particularly by insulating steel screws from aluminium surfaces. They may also be used in rotating applications, as a bearing. A thrust washer is used when a rolling element bearing is not needed either from a cost-performance perspective or due to space restraints. Coatings can be used to reduce wear and friction, either by hardening the surface or by providing a solid lubricant (i.e. a self-lubricating surface).
