Best was one of the first African American film actors and comedians to become well known. He was regularly hired as a character actor in Hollywood films after a talent scout discovered him on stage. The famous guitar solo, performed by Eddie Van Halen on "Beat It", was reproduced by "Weird Al" Yankovic's producer, Rick Derringer.
