It can lead to failure of treatment in people due to a decrease in drug concentrations, increase in clearance, or shorter half life. == History == b9687610c2 The glomerular filtration rate is the flow rate of filtered fluid through the kidney. The creatinine clearance rate (CCr or CrCl) is the volume of blood plasma that is cleared of creatinine per unit time and is a useful measure for approximating the GFR. Creatinine clearance exceeds GFR due to creatinine secretion, which can be blocked by cimetidine. Both GFR and CCr may be accurately calculated by comparative measurements of substances in the blood and urine, or estimated by formulas using just a blood test result (eGFR and eCCr). The results of these tests are used to assess the excretory function of the kidneys. Hepatorenal syndrome is slower in onset and progression, and is not associated with an inciting event. It is defined by an increase in serum creatinine level to $\geq 133 \mu\text{mol/L}$ b9687610c2

Augmented renal clearance Beginning in the late 1970s, an increase in the creatinine clearance had been observed in burn In pharmacology, augmented renal clearance (ARC) is a phenomenon where certain critically ill patients may display increased clearance of a medication through the kidneys. In many cases, it is observed as a measured creatinine clearance above that which is expected given the patient's age, sex, and other factors. Basic metabolic panel The BMP provides key information regarding fluid and electrolyte status, kidney function, blood sugar levels, and response to various medications and other medical therapies. Outside the United States, blood tests made up of the majority of the same biochemical tests are called urea and electrolytes (U&E or "U and Es"), or urea, electrolytes, creatinine (UEC or EUC or CUE), and are often referred to as 'kidney function tests' as they also include a calculated estimated glomerular filtration rate. Despite extensive speculation, the actual occurrence of contrast-induced nephropathy has not been demonstrated in the literature. Kidney failure Diagnosis of chronic failure is based on a glomerular filtration rate. combination of factors such as decreased urine production or increased serum creatinine

The version with seven tests is often referred to by medical professionals in the United States as the "CHEM-7", or "SMA-7" (Sequential Multiple Analysis-7). Normal kidney function measured by creatinine clearance varies in different populations based on age, gender, race, fluid balance, and other factors, but also can be affected by diseases themselves. This makes it challenging to assign an objective number or scale to kidney function. For this reason, kidney function (and thus medication elimination) has been approximated by measuring creatinine...
