Characteristic signs include pain, swelling, and ecchymosis around the thenar eminence, and especially over the MCP joint of the thumb. Physical examination demonstrates instability of the MCP joint of the thumb. Injuries to it cause instability and loss of function of the thumb. Acutely this injury is known as the Skier's thumb or if the result of chronic injury Gamekeeper's thumb.

Symptoms of gamekeeper's thumb are instability of the MCP joint of the thumb, accompanied by pain and weakness of the pinch grasp. The severity of the symptoms is related to the extent of the initial tear of the UCL (in the case of skier's thumb), or how long the injury has been allowed to progress (in the case of gamekeeper's thumb). 6bb6a63e8c

The ulnar nerve is trapped between the bone and the overlying skin at this point. This is commonly referred to as bumping one's "funny bone". This name is thought to be a pun, based on the sound resemblance between the name of the bone of the upper arm, the humerus, and the word "humorous". **Ulnar nerve** The ulnar nerve is a nerve that runs near the ulna, one of the two long bones in the forearm. The ulnar collateral ligament of elbow joint is in relation with the ulnar nerve. The nerve is the largest in the human body unprotected by muscle or bone, so injury is common. This nerve is directly connected to the little finger, and the adjacent half of the ring finger, innervating the palmar aspect of these fingers, including both front and back of the tips, perhaps as far back as the fingernail beds. This condition is commonly observed among gamekeepers and Scottish fowl hunters, as well as athletes (such as volleyballers and football goalkeepers). It also occurs among people who sustain a fall onto an outstretched hand while holding a rod, frequently skiers grasping ski poles. The UCL may be merely stretched, or it may be torn from its insertion site into the proximal phalanx of the thumb 6bb6a63e8c

It is on the radial side of the wrist, but on the ulnar side of the thumb. It should not be confused with the ulnar collateral ligament of wrist joint. 6bb6a63e8c

**Triphalangeal thumb** removing the extra phalanx and reconstructing the ulnar collateral ligament and the radial collateral ligament if necessary. In about two-thirds of the patients with triphalangeal thumbs, there is a hereditary component. The extra phalangeal bone can vary in size from that of a small pebble to a size comparable to the phalanges in non-thumb digits. It was first described by Columbi in 1559. The true incidence of the condition is unknown, but is estimated at 1:25,000 live births. For type III of Buck-Gramcko classification Triphalangeal thumb (TPT) is a congenital malformation where the thumb has three phalanges instead of two. Besides the three phalanges, there can also be other malformations 6bb6a63e8c
