The triangular-shaped peninsula is bounded by the median of the Brisbane River to the east, south and west. The CBD is located on a point on the northern bank of the Brisbane River, historically known as Meanjin, Mianjin or Meeanjin in the local Yuggera dialect. It is colloquially referred to as the "CBD", "the city", or simply "town". The peninsula, known at its tip as Gardens Point, slopes upward to the north-west where the city is bounded by parkland and the inner city suburb of Spring Hill to the north. To the west, the CBD is bounded by Milton, Petrie Terrace, and Kelvin Grove. The CBD is bounded to the north-east by the suburb of Fortitude Valley

German Lutherans established the first free... == Geography == The LGAs in the other mainland state capitals (Sydney, Melbourne, Perth and Adelaide) are generally responsible only for the central business districts and inner neighbourhoods of those cities. However, the City of Brisbane administers a significant portion of the Brisbane Greater Capital City Statistical Area (GCCSA), accounting for just under half its population. As such, it has a larger population than any other local government area in Australia. The City of Brisbane was the first Australian LGA to reach a population of more than one million. Its population is roughly equivalent to the populations of Tasmania, the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory combined. In 2016–2017, the council administered a budget of over \$3 billion, by far the largest budget compared to those of the City of Sydney and City of Melbourne LGAs.
