In humans, the lower end of the uterus is a narrow part known as the isthmus that connects to the cervix, the anterior gateway leading to the vagina. The upper end, the body of the uterus, is connected to the fallopian tubes at the uterine horns; the rounded part, the fundus, is above the openings to the fallopian tubes. The connection of the uterine cavity with a fallopian tube is called the uterotubal junction. The fertilized egg is carried to the uterus along the fallopian tube. It will have divided on its journey to form a blastocyst that will implant itself into the lining of the uterus - the endometrium, where it will receive nutrients and develop into the embryo proper, and later fetus, for the duration of the pregnancy...

A hypoplastic uterus is smaller than a normal uterus of reproductive age, generally under 6 cm (2.4 in) long, but has normal proportions, with the body of the uterus being twice the size of the cervix (2:1 ratio). An infantile uterus specifically refers to a uterus with proportions similar to those before menarche, with the body size ranging from as large as the cervix (1:1 ratio) to one-half as large as the cervix (1:2 ratio). There is no consensus on exact definitions of either term. One study of 29 women with uterine hypoplasia found that their uteri were cylindrical in shape. The length and shape of the uterus can be measured by ultrasound, while hysteroscopy is used to investigate the interior of the uterus. Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and hysterosalpingography...
