Drug test Numerous other methods with varying degrees of accuracy, sensitivity (detection threshold/cutoff), and detection periods exist. A drug test (also often toxicology screen or tox screen) is a technical analysis of a biological specimen, for example urine, hair, blood, breath, sweat A drug test (also often toxicology screen or tox screen) is a technical analysis of a biological specimen, for example urine, hair, blood, breath, sweat, or oral fluid/saliva—to determine the presence or absence of specified parent drugs or their metabolites. Major applications of drug testing include detection of the presence of performance enhancing steroids in sport, employers and parole/probation officers screening for drugs prohibited by law (such as cocaine, methamphetamine, and heroin) and police officers testing for the presence and concentration of alcohol (ethanol) in the blood commonly referred to as BAC (blood alcohol content). BAC tests are typically administered via a breathalyzer while urinalysis is used for the vast majority of drug testing in sports and the workplace cfc5ae2bd1

Ultrasound involves a probe that is placed near a structure and uses the transmission of ultrasound waves through a structure to produce images, after computer processing. Ultrasound of the urinary tract is performed by a probe placed on the abdominal wall, called a transducer. This occurs while a person is lying down. It is then moved around to better visualise different parts of the urinary tract. Gel is used on the abdominal wall, allowing smooth movement and improve sound conduction. The images are usually taken by a trained ultrasonographer, and then reported by a specialist radiologist. cfc5ae2bd1 Throughout history, there have been different animal-based tests with the aim of indicating the pregnancy status of women. The most well known test is the Hogben test, prevalent from the 1940s to the 1960s, by using the underlying principle of hormones and its subsequent biological response in both sexes of certain frog species. Advancements in medical technology have enabled women to accurately check their pregnancy status by using 'pee-on-a-stick' pregnancy test kits at home cfc5ae2bd1

Purple urine bag syndrome PUBS is most prevalent in elderly females with constipation. High bacterial counts in urine are the most important factor causing purple urine bag syndrome.

Bacteria in the urine can be found through bacteria culture test. Bacteria in urine produce the enzyme indoxyl sulfatase. plastic urine bags, as well as the presence of indigo. The purple discoloration is the result of reaction between indirubin and plastic urine bags, as well as the presence of indigo. People with purple urine bag syndrome Purple urine bag syndrome (PUBS) is a medical syndrome where purple discoloration of urine collection bag occurs in people with urinary catheters and co-existent urinary tract infections. Constipation alters the gut bacteria, reducing gastrointestinal motility and leading to increased growth of bacteria in the colon. This converts indoxyl sulfate in the urine into the red and blue colored compounds indirubin and indigo. People with urinary tract infections using catheters will increase the conversion of indoxyl sulfatase to indirubin and indigo. Indirubin dissolves in plastic and therefore causes urine discoloration cfc5ae2bd1

In mammals, urine travels from the kidneys via the ureters to the bladder for storage until urination. Paper strips are often specific to a single reaction (e.g. pH measurement), while the strips with pads allow several... cfc5ae2bd1 The Schilling test has multiple stages. As noted below, it can be done at any time after vitamin B12 supplementation and body store replacement, and some clinicians recommend that in severe deficiency cases, at least several weeks of vitamin repletion be done before the test (more than one B12 shot, and also oral folic acid), in order to ensure that impaired absorption of B12 (with or without intrinsic factor) is not occurring due to damage to the intestinal mucosa from the B12 and folate deficiency themselves. cfc5ae2bd1

A standard urine test strip may comprise up to 10 different chemical pads or reagents which react (change color) when immersed in, and then removed from, a urine sample. The test can often be read in as little as 60 to 120 seconds after dipping, although certain tests require longer. Routine testing of the urine with multiparameter strips is the first step in the diagnosis of a

wide range of diseases. The analysis includes testing for the presence of proteins, glucose, ketones, haemoglobin, bilirubin, urobilinogen, acetone, nitrite and leucocytes as well as testing of pH and specific gravity or to test for infection by different pathogens. cfc5ae2bd1
