Consequently, other regulatory approaches have emerged, such as water quality trading and voluntary community-level efforts. However, point source pollution remains an issue in some water bodies, due to some limitations of the Act. and other sources that are clearly discharging pollutants into water sources. The input of pollutants into a water body may impact the water's ability to Point source water pollution comes from discrete conveyances and alters the chemical, biological, and physical characteristics of water. Among other things, the Act requires dischargers to obtain a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to legally discharge pollutants into a water body

Water quality The most common standards used to monitor and assess water quality convey the health of ecosystems, safety of human contact, extent of water pollution and condition of drinking water. Water sources vary with time and with location. Water quality has a significant impact on water supply and often determines supply options. The measurement of interest may vary seasonally. Water quality refers to the chemical, physical, and biological characteristics of water based on the standards of its usage. A sample may be representative of the water source of interest. It is most frequently used by reference to a set of standards against which compliance, generally achieved through treatment of the water, can be assessed.

Ancient water features were powered using gravitational forces, human power or animals to pump in the water. Since the 18th century, the majority of water features have been powered by pumps. In the past, the power source was sometimes a steam engine, but in modern features it is almost always powered by electricity. There is an increasing range of innovative designs as the market becomes more established and people become more aware of alternate installation methods, such as solar power. The advantages of using solar power include environmental benefits, no electrical lines in the garden, and free energy.

Calling a water supply "tap water" distinguishes it from the other main types of fresh water which may be available; these include water from rainwater-collecting cisterns, water from village pumps or town pumps, water from wells, or water carried from streams, rivers, or lakes (whose potability may vary). According to the project's website, it is the largest underground network of pipes (2,820 kilometres (1,750 mi)) and aqueducts in the world. It consists of more than 1,300 wells, most of which are over 500 m deep, and supplies 6,500,000 m³ of fresh water per day to the cities of Tripoli, Benghazi, Sirte and elsewhere in Libya. The late Libyan leader Muammar Gaddafi described it as the "Eighth Wonder of the World".
