Derived from the word delusional, delulu originates in Internet communities obsessed with K-pop culture, such as the OneHallyu Forum active around 2013 and 2014. In these forums, delulu often mocked individuals who hoped, unrealistically, to meet a celebrity they idolized, a sign of a parasocial relationship with delusional beliefs. Users also often joked about being deluded themselves. 7e25d94ce3 In Zen, Makyō is a figurative reference to the kind of self-delusion that results from clinging to experience. Makyō used in a broad sense refers to people's attachments to experiences in their everyday lives. However, makyō may also be used in a more specific sense, referring to illusory experiences that sometimes occur during Zen meditation.

In Ayurvedic classics, hallucinations and delusions are referred to as false perceptions (mithyājñāna), illusions (maya), infatuations (moha), or confusion (bhrama). Russell specifically applied his analogy in the context of religion. He wrote that if he were to assert, without offering proof, that a teapot, too small to be seen by telescopes, orbits the Sun somewhere in space between the Earth and Mars, he could not expect anyone to believe him solely because his assertion could not be proven wrong. In Philip Kapleau's The

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Three Pillars of Zen, Hakuun Yasutani explained the term as the combination of "ma" meaning devil and "kyo" meaning the objective world. This character for "devil" can also refer to Mara, the Buddhist "tempter" figure; and the character kyo can mean simply region, condition or place. Makyō refers to the hallucinations and perceptual distortions that can arise during the course of meditation and can be mistaken by the practitioner as "seeing the true nature" or kenshō. Zen masters warn their meditating students to ignore sensory distortions. As Hakuun Yasutani states: 7e25d94ce3 In 1931 he became director of the German Psychiatric Research Institute in Munich, which was founded by Emil Kraepelin. He began his psychiatric training in Cologne; however, his

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training was interrupted by the first World War, in which he served on the Western Front. When his post-war career began, Schneider was influenced and mentored by Max Scheler, a philosophy professor and one of the co-founders of the phenomenological movement in philosophy. Scheler served as Schneider's supervisor for his postgraduate degree in philosophy in 1921.
