Purified water is usually produced by the purification of drinking water or ground water. Distilled water was the most common form of purified water but water is more frequently purified by other processes including capacitive deionization, reverse osmosis, carbon filtering, microfiltration, ultrafiltration, ultraviolet oxidation, or electrodeionization f2b9d56aae

Drinking mate Mate (MAH-tay; Spanish: mate ['mate], Brazilian Portuguese: ['matʃi]) is a caffeine-rich infused herbal drink made with yerba mate (*Ilex paraguariensis*), a plant which originates in the Southern Cone of South America. It is made by soaking dried yerba mate leaves in hot water and is traditionally served with a metal straw (bombilla) in a container typically made from a calabash gourd (also called the mate), from water-resistant hardwoods such as *Handroanthus impetiginosus* or Palo Santo, and also made from a cattle horn (guampa) in some areas. It is especially popular in South America and the Levant. It is also known as chimarrão in Portuguese, cimarrón in Spanish, and ka'ay in Guaraní. mate is the national drink of Argentina and Paraguay, where it is also consumed with either hot or ice cold water (see tereré); and Uruguay. Injecting reclaimed water into the water supply distribution system is known as direct potable reuse. Reusing wastewater as part of sustainable water management allows water to remain an alternative water source for human activities. For Water reclamation is the process of converting municipal wastewater or sewage and industrial wastewater into water that can be reused for a variety of purposes. This is especially so in arid countries. Reusing treated municipal wastewater for irrigation is a long-established practice

S. Increased variability and intensity of rainfall as a result of climate change is expected to produce both more severe droughts and flooding, with potentially serious consequences for water supply and for pollution from combined sewer overflows. Droughts are likely to particularly affect the 66 percent of Americans whose communities depend on surface water.
