Geography of Tunisia Tunisia occupies an area of 163,610 square kilometres, of which 8,250 are water. The principal and reliable rivers rise in the north of the country with a few notable exceptions from north-east Algeria and flow through the northern plain where sufficient rainfall supports diverse plant cover and irrigated agriculture. The country's geographic coordinates are 34°00'N 9°00'E. Economy of Tunisia Tunisia is considered a developing economy, classified as a Lower-middle Income country by the World Bank in 2023. From the 1st of January 2008 onwards, the country opened up to international trade with the adoption of the free trade agreement with the European Union in 1995, a process which increased in scale after the 2011 Arab Spring and subsequent political reforms. Prudent economic and fiscal planning has resulted in moderate but sustained growth for over a decade. Liberalisation efforts started in 1986 after three decades of dirigisme and state control of the economy. In 2010, liberalisation efforts led Tunisia is considered a developing economy, classified as a Lower-middle Income country by the World Bank in 2023.
