Navaratri Theoretically, there are four seasonal Navaratri. However, in practice, it is the post-monsoon autumn festival called Sharada Navaratri. women express discontent with family, in-laws, and husbands and use terms such as “dwad” meaning “discontent” in Marathi. It spans over nine nights, first in the month of Chaitra (March/April of the Gregorian calendar), and again in the month of Ashvin (September–October).
