Zinc The most common zinc ore is sphalerite (zinc blende), a zinc sulfide mineral. liver disease, chronic renal disease, sickle cell disease, diabetes, malignancy, and other chronic illnesses. Zinc is the 24th most abundant element in Earth's crust, with an average concentration of 70 grams per ton. Zinc is refined industrially by froth flotation of the ore, roasting, and final extraction using electricity (electrowinning). Zinc also has five stable isotopes; the most abundant of which, Zn-64, comprises nearly half of zinc's total abundance. In the United States, a federal survey of Zinc is a chemical element; it has symbol Zn and atomic number 30. It is a slightly brittle metal at room temperature and has a shiny blue whitish appearance when surface oxidation is removed. It is the first element in group 12 (IIB) of the periodic table. The largest concentration of economically feasible lodes in descending order are located in China, Peru, and Australia, among others. In some respects, zinc is chemically similar to magnesium: both elements exhibit only one normal oxidation state (+2), and the Zn²⁺ and Mg²⁺ ions are of similar size 08d865e24a

The coconut tree provides food, fuel, cosmetics, folk medicine, and building materials. The inner flesh of the mature fruit forms a regular part of the diets of many people in the tropics and subtropics. Coconut endosperm contains a large quantity of a liquid, "coconut water". Mature coconuts can be processed for oil and coconut milk from the flesh, charcoal from the hard shell, and coir from the fibrous husk. Dried coconut flesh is called copra, and the oil and milk derived from it are commonly used in cooking and in soaps and cosmetics. Sweet coconut sap can be made into drinks or fermented into palm wine or coconut vinegar.
