Chronic idiopathic pruritus or chronic pruritus of unknown origin is a form of itch that persists for longer than six weeks, and for which no clear cause can be identified. == History == Signs and symptoms == Shampoo is typically used to remove the unwanted build-up of sebum (natural oils) in the hair without stripping out so much as to make hair unmanageable. Shampoo is generally made by combining a surfactant, most often sodium lauryl sulfate or sodium laureth sulfate, with a co-surfactant, most often cocamidopropyl betaine in water. The sulfate ingredient acts as a surfactant, trapping oils and

Similar symptoms in older children are more likely to be dandruff than cradle cap. The rash is often prominent around the ear, the eyebrows or the eyelids. It may appear in other locations as well, where it is called infantile seborrheic dermatitis. Cradle cap is just a special—and more benign—case of this condition. The exact cause of cradle cap is not known. Cradle cap is not spread from person to person (not contagious). It is also not caused by poor hygiene. It is not an allergy, and it is not dangerous. Cradle cap often lasts a few months. In some children, the condition can last until age 2 or 3. c042f1c6d0 Abirritants consist of a large group of drugs belonging to different classes with varying mechanisms to treat itch. They may work either directly or indirectly to relieve itch, and evidence on their effectiveness varies from one class to another. Some alternative medicines are also used to treat itch. Side effects of abirritants also vary depending on the class of the drug. Even before the emergence of modern evidence-based medicine, abirritants had already been used in many civilizations, but practices and choice of drugs differ by culture. c042f1c6d0 Side effects of oral minoxidil may include low blood pressure, water retention and edema, salt retention, rapid heartbeat, dizziness, lightheadedness, headaches, excessive hair growth, and temporary hair shedding. When adults, they are about 2 to 3 mm long. When not attached to a human, they are unable to live beyond three days. Minoxidil generally well-tolerated, but common side effects include itching of the eyes, general itching, irritation at the treated area, and unwanted hair growth Minoxidil, sold under the brand names Loniten and Rogaine among others, is a medication used for the treatment of high blood pressure and hair loss. It may also be used off-label to promote beard growth and treat nail problems. It is available as a generic medication by prescription in oral tablet form and over-the-counter as a topical liquid or foam. Extended-release oral minoxidil and sublingual minoxidil formulations for hair loss are also being studied and developed. Oral minoxidil is used at high doses to treat high blood pressure and at low doses to treat hair loss, while topical minoxidil is used exclusively for hair loss and related indications. The drug promotes hair growth, but its effects are fully reversible and it does not slow or prevent hair loss c042f1c6d0

Eyelid staphylococcus infection and scalp dandruff. Its key function is to regularly spread the tears and other secretions on the eye surface to keep it moist, since the cornea must be continuously moist. The levator palpebrae superioris muscle retracts the eyelid, exposing the cornea to the outside, giving vision. A set of specialized hairs known as lashes grow from the upper and lower eyelid margins to further protect the eye from dust and debris. They keep the eyes from drying out when asleep. Moreover, the blink reflex protects the eye from foreign bodies. This can be either voluntarily or involuntarily. "Palpebral" (and "blepharal") means relating to the eyelids. characteristics. untreated chronic itch can lead to other skin diseases and/or progress into further skin damage. Diagnosis is based on an elimination criteria during a full body examination that can be done by either a dermatologist or non-dermatologist physician.
