Bitumen Whether found in natural deposits or refined from petroleum, the substance is classed as a pitch. In American English, the material is commonly referred to as asphalt. hydrothermal veins. The largest natural deposit of bitumen in the world is the Pitch Lake of southwest Trinidad, which is estimated to contain 10 million tons. Prior to the 20th century, the term asphaltum was in general use. Depending on its exact composition, it can be a sticky, black liquid or an apparently solid mass that behaves as a liquid over very large time scales. An example of this is within the Uinta Basin of Utah, in the US, where there is a swarm of laterally and vertically extensive veins composed Bitumen (UK: BIH-chuum-in, US: bih-TEW-min, by-) is an immensely viscous constituent of petroleum.
