Learning rate In the adaptive control literature, the learning rate is commonly referred to as gain. Since it influences to what extent newly acquired information overrides old information, it metaphorically represents the speed at which a machine learning model "learns". Momentum is analogous to a ball rolling down a hill; we want the ball to settle at the lowest point of the hill (corresponding to the lowest error). Momentum In machine learning and statistics, the learning rate is a tuning parameter in an optimization algorithm that determines the step size at each iteration while moving toward a minimum of a loss function

Fraction If the numerator and the denominator do not share any factor A fraction (from Latin: fractus, "broken") represents a part of a whole or, more generally, any number of equal parts. One says that the fraction has been reduced to its lowest terms. lowest absolute values. If these integers are positive, then the numerator represents a number of equal parts, and the denominator indicates how many of those parts make up a unit or a whole. When spoken in everyday English, a fraction describes how many parts of a certain size there are, for example, one-half, eight-fifths, three-quarters. A simple fraction (examples: 1/2 and 17/3) consists of an integer numerator, displayed above a line (or before a slash like 1/2), and a non-zero integer denominator, displayed below (or after) that line. For example, in the fraction 3/4, the numerator 3 indicates that the fraction represents 3 equal parts, and the denominator 4 indicates that 4 parts make up a whole. The picture to the right illustrates 3/4 of a cake

The correlation between a variable and a given factor, called the variable's factor loading, indicates the extent to which the two are related. Fractions can be used to represent ratios and division. Thus the fraction 3/4 can be used to represent the ratio 3:4 (the ratio of the part to the whole), and the division 3 ÷ 4 (three divided by four). Exploratory factor analysis EFA is based on the common factor model. EFA procedures are more accurate when each factor is represented by multiple measured variables in the. Measured variables are any one of several attributes of people that may be observed and measured. It is commonly used by researchers when developing a scale (a scale is a collection of questions used to measure a particular research topic) and serves to identify a set of latent constructs underlying a battery of measured variables. Researchers must carefully consider the number of measured variables to include in the analysis. In this model, manifest In multivariate statistics, exploratory factor analysis (EFA) is a statistical method used to uncover the underlying structure of a relatively large set of variables. more accurate when each factor is represented by multiple measured variables in the analysis. Usually, researchers would have a large number of measured variables, which are assumed to be related to a smaller number of "unobserved" factors. EFA is a technique within factor analysis whose overarching goal is to identify the underlying relationships between measured variables. Examples of measured variables could be the physical height, weight, and pulse rate of a human being. It should be used when the researcher has no a priori hypothesis about factors or patterns of measured variables 38c9574c04

While the descent direction is usually determined from the gradient of the loss function, the learning rate determines how big a step is taken in that direction. Factor analysis A common rationale behind factor analytic methods Factor analysis is a statistical method used to describe variability among observed, correlated variables in terms of a potentially lower number of unobserved variables called factors. The observed variables are modelled as linear combinations of the potential factors plus "error" terms, hence factor analysis can be thought of as a special case of errors-in-variables models. Factor analysis searches for such joint variations in response to unobserved latent variables. For example, it is possible that variations in six observed variables mainly reflect the variations in two unobserved (underlying) variables. and a given factor, called the variable's factor loading, indicates the extent to which the two are related 38c9574c04
