The first beacon was developed and installed in 2000 in Tucson, Arizona by R. B. Nassi, a then-transportation administrator for the city. He was inspired after a trip to Bristol in South West England where he saw a pelican crossing, he developed a prototype and his wife suggested the abbreviation HAWK. Prior to its full implementation, the HAWK beacon was categorized as an experimental device. 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several visual warning devices, which may be known as lightbars or beacons, fitted to a vehicle and used when the driver wishes to convey to other road users the urgency of their journey, to provide additional warning of a hazard when stationary, or in the case of law enforcement as a means of signalling another motorist that a traffic stop is being initiated. These lights may be dedicated emergency lights, such as a beacon or a lightbar, or modified stock lighting, such as a wig-wag or hideaway light, and are additional to any standard lighting on the car such as hazard lights. They are often used along with a siren system to increase their effectiveness and provide audible warnings alongside the visual warnings produced by the lights.

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Bioluminescence Bioluminescence has evolved independently at least 94 times, first emerging in octocorals some 540 million years ago. When stimulated by light, these turn on and off, causing rhythmic flashing. It occurs in a wide variety of organisms, including marine vertebrates and invertebrates, terrestrial arthropods such as fireflies, some fungi, and microorganisms such as some bacteria and dinoflagellates. has a pair of luminescent organs on either side of the inlet siphon. In some animals, the light is bacteriogenic, produced by symbiotic bacteria such as those from the genus *Vibrio*; in others, it is autogenic, produced by the animals themselves. No neural Bioluminescence is the production of light by an organism as the result of a chemiluminescence reaction

== History == Following a light-microscopy examination in 2001, it was initially thought that the rains were coloured by fallout from a hypothetical meteor burst,

The usual traffic light colors are red to stop traffic, amber to signal a change, and green to allow traffic to proceed. These are arranged vertically or horizontally in that order. In most cases, the principal chemical reaction in bioluminescence involves the reaction of a substrate called luciferin and an enzyme, called luciferase. Because these are generic names, luciferins and luciferases are often distinguished by the species or group, e.g. firefly luciferin or cypridina luciferin. In all characterized cases, the enzyme catalyzes the oxidation of the luciferin resulting in excited state oxyluciferin, which is the light emitter of the reaction. Upon their decay to the ground state they emit visible light.

Headlight flashing might have come into more common use as a

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means of attempting driver-to-driver communication by the mid-1970s, when cars began to come with headlight beam selectors located on the steering column—typically activated by pulling the turn signal stalk—rather than the previous foot-operated pushbutton switches. The signal stalk configuration was later wired to permit the momentary activation of the high beams regardless of whether the headlamp switch was turned on or off. Motorcycle headlamp modulators automatically oscillate the intensity of the headlamp in an effort to make the motorcycle more conspicuous to other drivers.
