Blackfoot Confederacy Sweet grass The Blackfoot Confederacy, Niitsítapi, or Siksikáí'tsitapi (ᑭᓴᓴᓴᓴᓴ, meaning "the people" or "Blackfoot-speaking real people"), is a historic collective name for linguistically related groups that make up the Blackfoot or Blackfeet people: the Siksika ("Blackfoot"), the Kainai ("Many Chiefs") or Blood, and two sections of the Peigan or Piegan or Piikani ("Splotchy Robe") – the Northern Piikani (Aapátóhsipikáni) and the Southern Piikani (Amskapi Piikani or Pikuni). Sage is said to rid the body of negative emotions such as anger. inhaling and covering themselves in the smoke in a process known widely as smudging. Broader definitions include groups such as the Tsùtínà (Sarcee) and A'aninin (Gros Ventre) who spoke quite different languages but allied with or joined the Blackfoot Confederacy 8a08e1a532

Among the most prominent are the animikeek or thunderbirds, who bring storms and are generally helpful to humans, and the Mishebeshu, underwater and underground serpents whose activities are often harmful. In

Ojibwe religion, a successful life is one that has secured the support of powerful manitouk, often through the provision of offerings like tobacco. Ojibwe religious practitioners undergo vision quests as a means of establishing a relationship with a particular manitou that becomes their guiding patron; prior to the 20th century, almost every Ojibwe male undertook this vision quest when they reached puberty. Ritual specialists, deemed to possess powers from the manitouk, are responsible for healing, locating game, and... 8a08e1a532 Historically, the member peoples of the Confederacy were nomadic bison hunters and trout fishermen, who ranged across large areas of the northern Great Plains of western North America, specifically the semi-arid shortgrass prairie ecological region. They followed the bison herds as they migrated between what are now the United States and Canada, as far north as the Bow River. In the first half of the 18th century, they acquired horses and firearms from white traders and their Cree and Assiniboiné go-betweens.
