Henna has been used in ancient Egypt, ancient Near East and the Indian subcontinent to dye skin, hair, and fingernails; Henna is a dye made from dried, powdered leaves of *Lawsonia inermis*, used to produce reddish stains used in body art. It originates in North Africa and the Middle East, and has been used since at least antiquity across the region, including in ancient Egypt, as well as in ancient Mesopotamia and broader pre-Islamic Arabian cultures, as a hair and body dye, notably in the temporary body art of mehndi (or “henna tattoo”) resulting from the staining of the skin using dyes from the henna plant 710cf5d224

The human body, apart from areas of glabrous skin, is covered in follicles which produce thick terminal and fine vellus hair. Most common interest in hair is focused on hair growth, hair types, and hair care, but hair is also an important biomaterial primarily composed of protein, notably alpha-keratin. 710cf5d224 It is an annual plant growing to 20–75 cm (7.9–29.5 in) tall, with a thick, but soft stem. The leaves are spirally-arranged, 2.5–9 cm (1.0–3.5 in) long and 1–2.5 cm broad, with a deeply toothed margin. The flowers are pink, red, mauve, purple, lilac, or white, and 2.5–5 cm diameter; they are pollinated by bees and other insects, and also by nectar-feeding birds. Juice from the leaves is used to treat warts and snakebite, and the flower is applied to burns. This species has been used as indigenous traditional medicine in Asia for rheumatism, fractures, and other ailments. In Korean folk medicine, this *impatiens* species is used as a medicine called bongseonhwa dae (뽕순화대) for the treatment of constipation and gastritis. Chinese people used the plant to treat those bitten by snakes or who ingested poisonous fish. However, due to large-scale demand and technological improvements, most dyes used in the modern world are synthetically produced from

Permanent makeup Permanent makeup, also known as permanent cosmetics, derma-pigmentation, micro-pigmentation, semi-permanent makeup and cosmetic tattooing, is a cosmetic technique which employs tattoos (permanent pigmentation of the dermis) as a means of producing designs that resemble makeup, such as eye-lining and other permanent enhancing colors to the skin of the face, lips, and eyelids. It is also used to restore or enhance the breast's areola, such as after breast surgery, or to give an illusion of more hair volume to the scalp. It is also used to produce artificial eyebrows, particularly in people who have lost them as a consequence of old age, disease, such as alopecia areata, alopecia totalis, chemotherapy, or a genetic disturbance, and to disguise scars and hypopigmentation in the skin such as in vitiligo 710cf5d224

Laser hair removal More hair may Laser hair removal is the process of hair removal by means of exposure to pulses of laser light that destroy the hair follicle. Laser hair removal is widely practiced in clinics, and even in homes using devices designed and priced for consumer self-treatment. Many reviews of laser hair removal methods, safety, and efficacy have been published in the dermatology literature. One of the first published articles describing laser hair removal was authored by the group at Massachusetts General Hospital in 1998. It had been performed experimentally for about twenty years before becoming commercially available in 1995–1996. to remove 100% of the hair from an area and is effective on hair of all colors, if used at an adequate power level with proper technique 710cf5d224

Hair highlighting Highlights can be any color, as long as it is a lighter level than the surrounding hair. Permanent hair dyes bleach and add a new color to hair through the penetration of smaller dye precursors into the cortex and subsequent oxidation. Hair dyes primarily come in two different forms: oxidative (permanent) and non-oxidative (semi-permanent and temporary). Most modern hair coloring relies on oxidative reactions. Despite changes in commercial formulations over time, the underlying chemistry has remained largely the same and commonly involves aromatic amines that function as dye precursors and coupling agents. These compounds are typically associated with products marketed as permanent hair dyes, although some semi-permanent formulations also rely on oxidative dye chemistry. 710cf5d224

Dye is generally applied in an aqueous solution and may require a mordant to improve the fastness of the dye on the fiber 710cf5d224

R. Rox Anderson and Melanie Grossman discovered that it was possible to selectively target a specific chromophore with a laser to partially damage basal stem cells inside the hair follicles. This method proved to be successful, and was first applied in 1996. In 1997, the United States Food and Drug Administration approved this tactic of hair removal. As this technology continued to be researched, laser hair removal became more effective and efficient; thus, it is now a common method in removing hair for long periods of time. 710cf5d224 Synthetic dyes are produced from various chemicals. The

great majority of dyes are obtained in this way because of their superior cost, optical properties (color), and resilience (fastness, mordancy). Both dyes and pigments are colored, because they absorb only some wavelengths of visible light. Dyes are usually soluble in some solvent, whereas pigments are insoluble. Some dyes can be rendered insoluble with the addition of salt to produce a lake pigment. 710cf5d224 Oxidative hair dye systems generally contain primary, secondary, or tertiary amines at concentrations of approximately 0.1–3%. These intermediates are relatively small and lipid-soluble molecules, properties that enable them to penetrate the hair shaft and, to some extent, the skin. Because oxidative dyes form larger colored molecules within the hair shaft through chemical reactions with oxidizing agents, the resulting pigments become trapped within the hair structure, producing longer-lasting coloration. 710cf5d224
