She sought to create a reusable menstrual product to compete with the existing disposable menstrual products on the market. Her invention was originally made with vulcanized rubber, and was considered to be a more comfortable and discreet alternative to the existing menstrual cup-like option. Menstrual pads are made from a range of materials, differing depending on style, country of origin, and brand. The pads are not the same as incontinence pads, which generally have higher absorbency and are worn by those who have urinary incontinence problems. Although menstrual pads are not made for this use, some use them for this purpose.
