Isosorbide mononitrate is a nitrate-class drug used for the prevention of angina pectoris. The sublingual patch has an onset of five minutes and a duration of action of one hour. The oral, slow release tablet has an onset of thirty minutes, and a duration of 8 hours. b7c96a7dd3 Common side effects include nausea, abdominal pain, and constipation. It may worsen the symptoms of asthma. Propranolol may cause harmful effects for the fetus if taken during pregnancy; however, its use during breastfeeding is generally considered to be safe. The mortality rate of diffuse neonatal hemangiomatosis is 50-90%. This condition affecting the liver is also known as infantile hepatic hemangioma (IHH). This disease is normally found in female Caucasian infants. This can cause high cardiac output, leading to further complications such as congestive heart failure.
