Drug-resistant epilepsy Drug-resistant epilepsy is commonly diagnosed after several years of uncontrolled seizures; however, in most cases, it is evident much earlier. Achieving seizure control in DRE patients is critical, as uncontrolled seizures can lead to irreversible damage to the brain, cognitive impairment, and increased risk for sudden unexpected death in epilepsy. For example, after two failed AEDs, the probability that the third will achieve seizure freedom is around 4%. Approximately 30% of people with epilepsy have a drug-resistant form. Indirect consequences of DRE include seizure. Functional MRI (fMRI) measures the change in blood flow and oxygenation Drug-resistant epilepsy (DRE), also known as refractory epilepsy, intractable epilepsy, or pharmacoresistant epilepsy, refers to a state in which an individual with a diagnosis of epilepsy is unresponsive to multiple first-line therapies. The ESR is influenced by the aggregation of red blood cells: blood plasma proteins, mainly fibrinogen, promote the formation of red cell clusters called rouleaux or larger structures (interconnected rouleaux, irregular clusters). As according to Stokes' law the sedimentation velocity varies like the square of the object's diameter, larger aggregates settle faster. While aggregation already takes place at normal physiological fibrinogen levels, these tend to increase when an inflammatory process is present, leading to increased ESR. 64bf9271c6 There are several types of arthritis.
