== Early life... == d0600518f6 Formed in 1995, the band consists of vocalist Corbett Redford III and guitarist/vocalist Dan Abbott. The duo is often joined onstage and in the studio by other musicians and participants for stage performances and recordings. Early performances featured occasional backup vocals from John Geek, who also sings for Fleshies. Abbott, Redford, and Geek were founding members of the indie label S.P.A.M. Records and organizers of Geekfest.

The second leg occurred from November 24 till December 19, 2000 with support from DMX, Godsmack and Sinistar in tow. Limp Bizkit finished the leg as headliners as it was the only Anger Management tour where Eminem did not finish, and instead, Limp Bizkit headlined over him. In this leg, three further dates were cancelled on November 26 and December 13 and 14. Rapper DMX missed four shows on the tour including a stop on December 17, where there was an issue and had to cancel his performance.

Haggard received many honors and awards, including a Kennedy Center Honor (2010); a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award (2006); a BMI Icon Award (2006); and induction into the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame (1977); Country Music Hall of Fame (1994) and Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame (1997).

The first "Anger Management" outing took place in 2000. The tour began two days after the release of Chocolate Starfish and the Hot Dog Flavored Water on October 19, 2000. On the first leg Limp Bizkit and Eminem co-headlined with support from D12, Papa Roach and Xzibit. They played through November 21, 2000. Four dates on the first leg were cancelled or rescheduled due to Fred Durst's swollen vocal chords. October 24 and November 3, 15 and 19.

Afterward, they put out three officially-released lo-fi albums: *GodWeenSatan: The Oneness* (1990); *The Pod* (1991); and *Pure Guava* (1992). For *Pure Guava*, the band signed with major label Elektra Records. The album spawned the single "Push th' Little Daisies", which was a chart hit in Australia and the United States. Under Elektra, the band released four professionally-recorded albums: *Chocolate and Cheese* (1994); *12 Golden Country Greats* (1996); *The Mollusk* (1997); and *White Pepper* (2000). They later returned to independent labels for their albums *Quebec* (2003) and *La Cucaracha* (2007).
