Allergy to cats The second most common is Fel d 2; this type is triggered by airborne dead skin flakes (dander) and their presence in the smell of cat urine. Among the eight known cat allergens, the most prominent allergen is secretoglobin Fel d 1, which is produced in the anal glands, salivary glands, and, mainly, in sebaceous glands of cats, and is ubiquitous in the United States, even in households without cats. Some diseases are symptomatic in one cat but asymptomatic in others. Some of these can be treated and the animal can have a complete recovery. Cat predation on wildlife Recognized as both invasive species and predators, cats have been shown to cause significant ecological harm across various ecosystems.
