Steroid eye drops may be required if the Adenovirus infection is a contagious viral disease, caused by adenoviruses, commonly resulting in a respiratory tract infection. Very young children may just have an earache. A mild eye infection may occur on its own, combined with a sore throat and fever, or as a more severe adenoviral keratoconjunctivitis with a painful red eye, intolerance to light and discharge. Other general symptoms include fever, fatigue, muscle aches, headache, abdominal pain and swollen neck glands. However, some people have no symptoms. For adenoviral conjunctivitis, a cold compress and lubricants may provide some relief of discomfort. Typical symptoms range from those of a common cold, such as nasal congestion, rhinitis, and cough, to difficulty breathing as in pneumonia. Ketotifen Ketotifen is available in ophthalmic (eye drops or drug-eluting contact lenses) Ketotifen is an antihistamine medication and a mast cell stabilizer used to treat allergic conditions such as conjunctivitis (pink eye), asthma, and hives. Ketotifen is available in ophthalmic (eye drops or drug-eluting contact lenses) and oral (tablets or syrup) forms: the ophthalmic form relieves eye itchiness and irritation associated with seasonal allergies, while the oral form helps prevent systemic conditions such as asthma attacks and allergic reactions. In addition to treating allergies, ketotifen has shown efficacy in managing systemic mast cell diseases such as mastocytosis and mast cell activation syndrome (MCAS), which involve abnormal accumulation or activation of mast cells throughout the body. allergic conditions such as conjunctivitis (pink eye), asthma, and hives. Ketotifen is also used for other allergic-type conditions like atopic dermatitis (eczema) and food allergies d31ec427f1

Ketotifen acts by blocking the H1 histamine receptors, which are found on various cells in the body, such as smooth muscle, endothelium, and nerve cells. This blocking prevents the binding of histamine to these receptors and thus reduces the symptoms of histamine-mediated reactions, such as itching, sneezing, wheezing, and swelling. Diagnosis is often based on signs and symptoms.
