I've started experiencing a new behavior when using rollback (on one Win XP computer + newest Firefox, I'll check newer Windows platforms later). The most annoying one is that "blind" rollback (rollback without viewing the diff) now requires confirmation - an extra page pops up asking 'do you want to revert this edit' OK? Does anyone know where this implementation was discussed and how to bypass this feature? I've lost a quick rollback function for dealing with obvious vandals. I followed "What links here" from Template:@ to the article Sierra Leone, because I was trying to figure out why a template designed to prevent bots from grabbing email addresses on Wikipedia pages was also being used in an article. What I found, searching the wikitext, was this template: d256ae54fc

And yet, looking at Special:WhatLinksHere/Raghuvamsa shows a lot of pages that don't actually link to Raghuvamsa but merely transclude Template:Ramayana. Similarly, Special:WhatLinksHere/Raghuvamsa_(dynasty) doesn't show a lot of pages which do transclude Template:Ramayana and hence link to it. (A couple of days ago I manually went and made minor edits to quite a few pages that use the template so that the table got updated, but I've decided to ask about investigating the bug now.) What's going... d256ae54fc I have experienced the Visual Editor always timing out whenever I tried to make even minor edits to some of the large, higher-traffic generating, most-watched articles such as Barack Obama, PlayStation 3 and World War II. Anybody else experiencing this issue, especially with pages

with combined tons of content, templates, images and citations? If so, that is not very good...

If I'm reading Help:What links here and Manual:Job queue correctly, it appears that when a link in a template is changed, the links table gets updated in a while, via the job queue. That is, if page A transcludes template T, then when the template T is edited to add or remove page B, eventually the backlinks (what links to page B) will be updated, automatically, to include to exclude page A (respectively). Is this right?

The error message is: "Error saving data to server: timeout". This error message is generated by the Visual Editor itself, not the standard server-side MediaWiki error message mentioned in that bugzilla case.

It appears that both Wikipedia and Commons refuse to allow file uploads with similar names. For example, if a poor-quality file named blah.jpg exists, and I want to upload an SVG equivalent of better quality called blah.svg, none of the dialogs permits the file to be uploaded, even though the name is clearly different. The system tells me that a file by that name already exists, yet when I try to access the file named blah.svg, it isn't there, either on Wikipedia or on Commons. As recently as a few weeks ago, there was no issue in using the same base file name, as long as the file name extension

wasn't the same and the file type was different. In some cases the the original file name is poorly chosen and it is desirable to give the vector replacement file a different name, but in other cases forcing the user to change the base name is simply chicanery. The way it originally worked, the dialog would simply warn the user that a file with a chosen name already existed, but it wouldn't absolutely prevent the user from uploading it.
