Archived from Hip resurfacing is a surgical alternative to total hip replacement (THR). When the person moves the hip, the movement of the joint induces synovial fluid to flow between the hard metal bearing surfaces lubricating them when the components are placed in the correct position. The procedure consists of placing a cap (usually made of cobalt-chrome metal), which is hollow and shaped similarly to the cap of a mushroom, over the head of the femur while a matching metal cup (similar to what is used with a THR) is placed in the acetabulum (pelvis socket), replacing the articulating surfaces of the person's hip joint and removing very little bone compared to a THR. 90B9 daf431f2e7

== Medical uses == daf431f2e7 There are several types of arthritis. The most common forms are osteoarthritis (most commonly seen in weight-bearing joints) and rheumatoid arthritis. Osteoarthritis usually occurs as a person ages and often affects the hips, knees, shoulders, and fingers. Rheumatoid arthritis is an autoimmune disorder that often affects the hands and feet. Other types

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of arthritis include gout, lupus, spondyloarthritis, and septic arthritis. These are inflammatory based types of rheumatic disease. Possible causes include previous joint injury, abnormal joint or limb development, and inherited factors. Risk is greater in those who are overweight, have legs of different lengths, or have jobs that result in high levels of joint stress. Hip replacement A total hip replacement (total hip arthroplasty) consists of replacing both the acetabulum and the femoral head while hemiarthroplasty generally only replaces the femoral head. range of €7,117 to €11,091 in most European countries. Hip replacement surgery can be performed as a total replacement or a hemi/semi(half) replacement. Hip replacement is one of the most common orthopaedic operations. The average cost of a total hip replacement in 2012 was \$40,364 in the United States (about €37,300), and in the range of €7,117 to €11,091 in most European countries. Total hip replacement is most commonly used to treat joint failure caused by osteoarthritis. Patient satisfaction varies widely between different techniques and implants. Approximately 58% of total hip replacements are estimated to last 25 years. Other Hip replacement is a surgical procedure in which the hip joint is replaced by a prosthetic implant, that is, a hip prosthesis. Such joint replacement orthopaedic surgery is generally conducted to relieve arthritis pain or in some hip fractures

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
