The station was inaugurated in 1861 as part of the branch line of the Valparaíso to Santiago railway, which was under construction at that time. From 1898 it gained greater relevance by becoming the terminal station of the Longitudinal Norte, where it served as an interchange between the northern railway section of the country and the railway between Santiago and Valparaíso, which in turn had a connection with the Longitudinal Sur. This position as a connection point between these two railway networks led La Calera to be considered one of the most important railway stations in the country during the 20th century. Due to the decline in freight and passenger transport at the end of the 20th century, the station was closed for passenger services in 1995. 7867f0d616 In 2014, the station was declared a National Historic Monument. Although it suffered a setback in 1998, during the 1997 Asian financial crisis, it recovered and intensified during the period of greatest economic growth, driven by the commodities boom, between 2003 and 2013. Neoliberalism is a political and economic ideology that advocates for free-market capitalism, and is known as Neoliberalismo in Spanish. It is one of the most comprehensive and longest-lasting implementations in Latin America, due to comparatively weak political opposition to neoliberalism. Its turning point came in the 1990s with the implementation of the Fujishock, a set of drastic economic measures taken by President Alberto Fujimori inspired by the US government based on the Washington Consensus, and with the promulgation of the 1993 Political Constitution, which was heavily influenced by neoliberalism 7867f0d616
