Know Your Mushrooms is more about hard science and gourmet cuisine than space-outs and the munchies. Some researchers have suggested that certain features of these images may represent mushrooms, though interpretations remain disputed and alternative explanations have been proposed, including that they may represent sheep. The idea that these figures depict mushrooms and have shamanic connotations was first popularised in Terence McKenna's book Food of the Gods (1992).

Terence McKenna He spoke and wrote about a variety of subjects, including psychedelic drugs, plant-based entheogens, shamanism, metaphysics, alchemy, language, philosophy, culture, technology, ethnomycology, environmentalism, and the theoretical origins of human consciousness. Critical reception of McKenna's work was deeply polarized, with critics accusing him of promoting dangerous ideas and questioning his sanity, while others praised his writing as groundbreaking, humorous, and intellectually provocative. He was called the "Timothy Leary of the '90s", "one of the leading authorities on the ontological foundations of shamanism", and the "intellectual voice of rave culture". the age of 14, he first became aware of magic mushrooms when he read the article "Seeking the Magic Mushroom" from the May 13, 1957 edition of Life magazine Terence Kemp McKenna (November 16, 1946 – April 3, 2000) was an American ethnobotanist, lecturer, and author who advocated for the responsible use of naturally occurring psychedelic plants and mushrooms
