The Russian aviation industry is largely state-owned and centrally controlled, with little strategic private competition. In 1992, following the dissolution of the Soviet Union, Aeroflot was divided into approximately 400 regional airlines informally known as Babyflots and was restructured into an open joint-stock company. be558fd5ca

Antonov Airlines and Russian fleets allowed them to share the combined An-124-100 commercial fleet of seventeen aircraft (twelve of which belonged to Antonov Airlines). Antonov Airlines is a Ukrainian cargo airline, a division of the Antonov aviation company. Its main base was Hostomel Airport near Kyiv. In the aftermath of the Battle of Hostomel Airport in 2022, Antonov relocated its remaining aircraft to Leipzig/Halle Airport in Germany. According to the World Bank, Russia's strong short-term macroeconomic fundamentals made it better prepared than many emerging economies to deal with the crisis, but Russia's underlying structural weaknesses and high dependence on the price of a single commodity made the crisis' impact more pronounced than would otherwise be the case be558fd5ca

Since the 1980s, there has been a trend of major airline mergers and the formation of partnerships or alliances for codeshare agreements, in which they both offer and operate the same flight. The largest alliances are Star Alliance, SkyTeam and Oneworld. Airline alliances coordinate their passenger service programs (such as lounges and frequent-flyer programs), offer special interline tickets and often engage in extensive codesharing (sometimes systemwide). be558fd5ca
