Before the year 1900, abortion remained largely illegal in Virginia, reflecting a widespread trend in many U.S. states during the 19th and early 20th centuries. In 1950, the University of Virginia Hospital established a review board responsible for evaluating and approving abortion requests, particularly those grounded in psychiatric reasons.
