== Structure and development == fffd53c8f3 To locate the natural waistline, one need simply stand upright and then tilt over to the side, keeping the legs and hips straight. Where the torso creases is the natural waistline. fffd53c8f3

Following umbilical cord clamping during delivery, the umbilicus base will spontaneously separate within 7–15 days. With routine cord care and proper hygienic conditions, the remaining umbilical base will heal and new skin tissue will form. In some instances, a mass of tissue, or granuloma, will form at the base. fffd53c8f3 == Description == fffd53c8f3 Babies are prone to this malformation because of the process during fetal development by which the abdominal organs form outside the abdominal... fffd53c8f3

Umbilical cord the point which (after separation) will become the navel (umbilicus or belly button). The umbilical vein supplies the fetus with oxygenated, nutrient-rich blood from the placenta. Conversely, the fetal heart pumps low-oxygen, nutrient-depleted blood through the umbilical arteries back to the placenta. Within the fetus, the umbilical vein continues towards the transverse In placental mammals, the umbilical cord (also called the navel string, birth cord or funiculus umbilicalis) is a conduit between the developing embryo or fetus and the placenta. During prenatal

development, the umbilical cord is physiologically and genetically part of the fetus and (in humans) normally contains two arteries (the umbilical arteries) and one vein (the umbilical vein), buried within Wharton's jelly fffd53c8f3

Belly fetish belly-to-belly contact stimulates pathways related to thermoregulation and homeostasis. A study of 51 newborns found that SSC with belly-to-belly touch A belly fetish (also known as a stomach fetish, or alvinolagnia) is a partialism in which an individual is sexually attracted to the midriff or belly fffd53c8f3

Waist Normally, it is the narrowest part of the torso. Where the waist is convex rather than concave, as in pregnancy and obesity The waist is the part of the abdomen between the rib cage and hips. smallest circumference of the natural waist, usually just above the belly button fffd53c8f3

Because of this and because the waist is often synonymous with the

stomach, one can become confused as to the exact location of the waist. Another confusing factor is that the waistline differs on different people. A study showed that self-reported measurements, as opposed to measurement done by a technician, underestimated waist circumference and this underestimation increased with increased body size. In the study, waist circumference measured at the level of the umbilicus was larger than that measured at the natural waist. fffd53c8f3 Waistline refers to the horizontal line where the waist is narrowest, or to the general appearance of the waist. fffd53c8f3 The belly is widely considered as an erogenous region, meaning it holds multiple nerve endings that make it sensitive to various sensations. Therefore, having a belly fetish usually coincides with belly-related sexual acts including but not limited to pressing a partner's belly, touching/rubbing the belly region, using sex toys and other objects (e.g., food, candles, ice, feathers, massage oils) to stimulate the belly region, rubbing one's belly against a partner's belly, or licking or sucking the navel. For this reason, belly fetishism (alvinolagnia) often co-exists with navel fetishism (alvinophilia).

Umbilical granuloma Silver nitrate is the most common treatment and practiced worldwide Umbilical granuloma is the most common umbilical abnormality in newborn children or neonates, causing inflammation and drainage. It is the overgrowth of the umbilical tissue. It may appear in the first few weeks of newborn infants during the healing process of the umbilical cord due to an umbilical mass. navel area with soap and sterile water, followed by open exposure of the belly button to air. With appropriate treatment, it is expected to heal in 1~2 weeks. It develops in about 1 out of 500 newborns fffd53c8f3

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation emphasized. The order of interventions was changed for all age groups except newborns from airway, breathing, chest compressions (ABC) to chest compressions fffd53c8f3

There are no signs during pregnancy. About sixty percent of infants with gastroschisis are born prematurely. At birth, the baby will have a relatively small (<4cm) hole in the abdominal wall, usually...
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Gastroschisis The size of the hole is variable, and other organs including the stomach Gastroschisis is a birth defect in which the baby's intestines extend outside of the abdomen through a hole next to the belly button. The size of the hole is variable, and other organs including the stomach and liver may also occur outside the baby's body. intestines extend outside of the abdomen through a hole next to the belly button. Complications may include feeding problems, prematurity, intestinal atresia, and intrauterine growth restriction fffd53c8f3

The cause is typically unknown. Rates are higher in babies born to mothers who smoke, drink alcohol, or are younger than 20 years

old. Ultrasounds during pregnancy may make the diagnosis. Otherwise, diagnosis occurs at birth. It differs from omphalocele in that there is no covering membrane over the intestines. fffd53c8f3

Umbilical hernia The bulge can often be pressed back through the hole in the abdominal wall, and may "pop out" when coughing or otherwise acting to increase intra-abdominal pressure. It may cause the navel to bulge outwards—the bulge consisting of abdominal fat from the greater omentum or occasionally parts of the small intestine. Umbilical granulomas occur after umbilical cord removal when the remaining ring of the umbilicus undergoes incomplete wound

healing and there is excessive healing tissue, also known as granulation tissue. Delayed cord separation, mild infections and hygienic conditions are all factors which may contribute to the incidence of umbilical granuloma. Although the exact cause of umbilical granulomas is unknown, it is hypothesized that inflammation of the remaining... Treatment involves surgery. This typically occurs shortly after birth. In those with large defects, the exposed organs may be covered with a special material and slowly moved back into the abdomen. This condition affects about 4 per 10,000 newborns. Rates of the condition appear to be increasing. == Signs and symptoms == A hernia is present at the site of the umbilicus (commonly called a navel or belly button) in newborns; although sometimes quite large, these hernias tend to resolve without any treatment by around the age of 2-3 years. Obstruction and strangulation of the hernia is rare because the underlying defect in the abdominal wall is larger than in an inguinal hernia of the newborn. The size of the base of the herniated tissue is inversely correlated with risk of strangulation

(i.e., a narrow base is more likely to strangulate). fffd53c8f3
