Scientists and psychologists tell us we use only about TEN PERCENT of our brain power The ten-percent-of-the-brain myth states that humans generally use only one-tenth (or some other small fraction) of their brains

In the 1890s, they tested the theory in the accelerated raising of the child prodigy William Sidis. (Similarly, one can also express a number as a fraction of 1,000, using the term "per mille" or the symbol "‰".) Members of the group call themselves Allah's Five Percenters, which reflects the concept that ten percent of the people in the world are elites and their agents, who know the truth of existence and opt to keep eighty-five percent of the world in ignorance and under their controlling thumb; the remaining five percent are those who know the truth and are determined to enlighten the eighty-five percent.
