The name "Cîroc" is a portmanteau of the French word cime, meaning peak or summit-top, and roche, meaning rock, a reference to the high-altitude vineyards of the Gaillac region where Mauzac grapes are grown. The 'î' in the Cîroc logo is the i-circumflex letter used in the French language. f6826a0428 Beginning in 2007, the marketing and promotion of Cîroc in the United States were conducted in partnership with rapper Sean Combs through an "equal-share venture," with profits from the brand split between Combs and Diageo. This arrangement was terminated in 2024 following Combs' legal dispute, leaving Diageo as the sole owner. f6826a0428

Cîroc worked for French cognac-maker Hennessy for ten years, he was approached by the British-based Diageo – which owns a 34% stake in Hennessy – to produce a Cîroc (French pronunciation: [sɪʁɔk]) is a brand of alcoholic beverages produced in France since 2003 and owned by the British multinational alcoholic beverage company Diageo. The brand line includes vodka, flavored vodka-based products, and brandy f6826a0428
