Urinary catheterization of urinary tract infections when silver-alloy catheters are used. A catheter may be in place for long periods of time (indwelling catheter) or removed after each use (intermittent catheterization). Common indications for urinary catheterization include acute or chronic urinary retention Urinary catheterization is the insertion of a latex, polyurethane, or silicone tube known as a urinary catheter into the bladder through the urethra to allow urine to drain from the bladder for collection. A clinician, often a nurse, usually performs the procedure, but self-catheterization is also possible. It may also be used to inject liquids used for treatment or diagnosis of bladder conditions 77b255318c

Lower urinary tract symptoms The term is more commonly applied to men – over 40% of older men are affected – but lower urinary tract symptoms also affect women. Other pathogens such as Proteus mirabilis, Klebsiella pneumoniae, and Staphylococcus saprophyticus can also cause UTIs. 77b255318c

Mecillinam against Gram-negative bacteria. Because mecillinam has very low oral bioavailability, an orally active prodrug was developed: pivmecillinam. It is used primarily in the treatment of urinary tract infections, and has also

Nitrofurantoin, trimethoprim-sulfamethoxazole (TMP/SMX), fosfomycin, and pivmecillinam are currently the first-line agents for empiric therapy of simple cystitis. On the other hand, the choice of empiric antimicrobial therapy for pyelonephritis depends on the severity of illness, specific host factors, and the presence of resistant bacteria. Ceftriaxone is often considered for parenteral treatment, while oral or parenteral fluoroquinolones, such as levofloxacin and ciprofloxacin, are suitable alternatives for treating pyelonephritis. 77b255318c Ultrasound involves a probe that is placed near a structure and uses the transmission of ultrasound waves through a structure to produce images, after computer processing. Ultrasound of the urinary tract is performed by a probe placed on the abdominal wall, called a transducer. This occurs while a person is lying down. It is then moved around to better visualise different parts of the urinary tract. Gel is used on the abdominal wall, allowing smooth movement and improve sound conduction. The images are usually taken by a trained ultrasonographer, and then reported by a specialist radiologist. 77b255318c

Urinary tract infection Lower UTIs A urinary tract infection (UTI) is an infection that affects a part of the urinary tract, which includes the bladder, urethra and the kidney. Symptoms may be less clear in very young or old people. Symptoms from a lower UTI include burning or pain during urination, pain in the lower abdomen and the urge to urinate even when the bladder is empty. Symptoms of a kidney infection are more systemic and include fever or flank pain, usually in addition to the symptoms of a lower UTI. While antibiotics are widely used to treat them, the recurrence of UTIs poses a significant challenge. Long-term antibiotic use not only poses health risks but also contributes to the

growing problem of antibiotic resistance, making effective treatment more challenging. 77b255318c Mecillinam is used in the treatment of infections due to susceptible gram-negative bacteria, especially urinary tract infections which are most commonly caused by *Escherichia coli*. Mecillinam is active against most pathogenic Gram-negative bacteria, except *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and some species of *Proteus*. Several studies have also found it to be as effective as other antibiotics for treating *Staphylococcus saprophyticus* infection, though it is Gram-positive, possibly because mecillinam reaches very high concentrations in urine. 77b255318c == Symptoms and signs == 77b255318c Prior to the test, a medical practitioner will have conducted a medical history to evaluate for symptoms that may relate to the urinary tract. 77b255318c

Causes include blockage of the urethra, nerve problems, certain medications, and weak bladder muscles. Blockage can be caused by benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH), urethral strictures, bladder stones, a cystocele, constipation,

or tumors. Nerve problems can occur from diabetes, trauma, spinal cord problems, stroke, or heavy metal poisoning. Medications that can cause problems include anticholinergics, antihistamines, tricyclic antidepressants, cyclobenzaprine, diazepam, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID), stimulants, and opioids. Pyelonephritis may be preventable by urination after sex and drinking sufficient fluids. Once present it is generally treated with antibiotics, such as ciprofloxacin or ceftriaxone. Those with severe disease may require treatment in hospital. Urinary retention When it is of sudden onset, symptoms include an inability to urinate and lower abdominal pain,

while symptoms accompanying gradual onset may include loss of bladder control, mild lower abdominal pain, and a weak urine stream. Onset can be sudden or gradual. == Medical uses == 77b255318c The most common cause of infection is E. coli, though other bacteria or fungi may sometimes be the cause. Risk factors include being female, sexual intercourse, diabetes, using a catheter, and family history. Additional factors that have been found to increase the risk of infection include urinary retention (delaying urination), insufficient water intake, use of spermicides as a contraceptive method, and poor genital hygiene. 77b255318c Treatment is typically with a catheter either through the urethra or lower abdomen... 77b255318c Catheters come in several basic designs: 77b255318c

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
