== Signs and symptoms ==

Health and appearance of Michael Jackson From the mid-1980s, Jackson's appearance began to change dramatically. His Michael Jackson (1958–2009) was an American entertainer who spent over four decades in the public eye, first as a child star with the Jackson 5 and later as a solo artist. Antiemetics are sometimes necessary to suppress nausea and vomiting. In the United States, occupational heat stress is becoming more significant as the average temperatures increase but remains overlooked.
